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
PLEASE READ BEFORE YOU GET TO ORLANDO!!

Greetings: Read this and you'll be "in the know" and will have a more enjoyable conference experience.

The conference July 8-11, 2009 at the Rosen Shingle Creek Resort (407-996-9936) begins at 6:30pm Wednesday July 8, but please note that pre-conference institutes begin as early as Mon, July 6, at 8:30am. Please check the website or the conference brochure for the schedule.

When you arrive, come to the Smart Marriages registration desk outside the Gatlin Ballroom to pick up your badge. **You must wear your badge for admission to all events** - keynotes, workshops, institutes, and banquets. You'll find a workshop room locator in your on-site packet plus the most recent updates and notices.

<u>Workshop assignments:</u> Your workshop numbers & banquet tickets will be printed on your badge. Here is a sample to help you understand how it works.



Keynote/plenary sessions are included in your registration but don't appear on your badge. If you're registered for the full conference, you are registered for 11 plenary sessions including lunch keynotes Thurs, Fri & Sat and the Fri & Sat night events. If you registered for only one day, your badge admits you to the keynotes that day. Arrive at keynotes early to win Door Prizes! Drawings are held 5 mins before sessions begin. If you're registered for the conference, you are automatically registered for the drawings but you must be present in the ballroom to win.

It's not too late to register your spouse or significant other. That's always the #1 complaint: "Why didn't you tell me to bring my spouse?!" It's that kind of conference. You can still add your spouse at the early-bird rate!

<u>Banquets</u> are THE networking events of the conference. Your "tickets" appear on your badge as Tu/B-1, Th/B-2, etc. B-1 denotes a banquet you purchased for yourself, B-2, B-4, etc indicate tickets you purchased for guests. There are two banquets, Tues July 7 (Tu) and Thurs July 9 (Th). The Fireproof Lunch is Wed July 8 W/LH. <u>To add banquets, the Fireproof lunch, institutes or register</u> your spouse, call 651-789-3738 or email smc@cmehelp.com by June 29th.

Getting to the Hotel from the Airport: Approx 25 mins. Shuttle \$18 one way; \$29 round trip - departs every 15 mins from the baggage level. No reservation needed. However, before you purchase a roundtrip ticket, know that for the return trip, you must reserve the night before and the shuttle company requires you to leave the hotel 4 hrs before your flight time to allow stops at other hotels! You might, instead, choose to use the message board to find a taxi buddy (or three). Taxi \$42 for up to 4 passengers/25 mins.

We're at a resort! Think palm trees, pools, spa, tennis, golf. Everything is in our self-contained oasis - including dining. No nearby, walk-to restaurants this year, but, the Shingle Creek has it covered with great restaurants on the property: Café Osceola 7am-10pm - breakfast, lunch & dinner buffets or a la cart menu. 18 Monroe Street - 24-hr NY-deli plus hot take-out from 6:30am - 11:30pm. Cala Bella -fine Italian dining 5:30-10pm. A Land Remembered - Steakhouse - lunch & dinner in an elegant clubhouse setting. Advance reservations recommended for Cala Bella and the Steakhouse. Cat-Tails - burgers et al by the pool, 11am-6pm. Headwaters Lounge - noon to 1am watering hole. Smooth Java off the lobby for Starbucks coffee & snacks and the Ice Creamery off the pool.

The Wednesday night dinner crunch: Attending a pre-conference Institute? You'll have only an hour for dinner before the opening keynote session. Institutes end at 5:30pm, Keynote begins at 6:30pm. Plan ahead! Also plan where you'll eat on Fri & Sat so you can get to the IMAGO Dialogue & Marketing plenaries at 7:30pm. Especially plan ahead if you want to attend the Film Festival 5:30pm Fri & Sat. Buy your sandwich well in advance!

The EXHIBITS are the heart of the conference – the "town square" – each exhibit a mini-marriage-education workshop unto itself. Sample the programs. Check out what's new. Ask questions you didn't have time for in the sessions. Register for door prizes (bring plenty of business cards). Get books signed - bring a camera! The Exhibit area is also the location of conference registration desk, message boards, poster sessions, and recording sales. The recording discounts are good only for orders placed at the conference.

- <u>Check the list of registrants</u> by state, city & country at the registration desk to connect with those from your area. Use the message boards to meet for coffee, lunch, dinner, golf, drinks.
- Opening Night Reception: Wed 8:30pm, following the opening plenary. The plenary (6:30-8:30pm) is at the dinner hour so eat <u>before</u> the session. The reception cheese, grapes, crackers, chips, punch, and a cash bar is not a meal.
- Opening Night Gatherings Wed 8:30pm following the Reception: Singles, United Methodists, Family Wellness, Catholics, Utah, LGBT, ACME, Marriage-Friendly Therapists.
- <u>Singles Only:</u> Bonus session Wed 8:45pm, Gatlin E4, *How to Avoid Falling for a Jerk* with **John Van Epp.** Get a **singles sticker** at the registration desk so you can recognize & meet other singles. For never-married, divorced, widowed. 1.5hrs CE
- <u>Bonus: Marriage Film Festival: Tues</u> Sat. Seven films: *Hold Me Tight; Fireproof; Couplehood As a Spiritual Path, Secretsto Love; Crossing the Bridge; Children of Divorce: Somebody's Daughter.* Bring a sandwich so you can eat and still make it to the 7:30pm Fri & Sat evening keynotes on time! - What to Pack: Avg temp 92 high, 73 low. With the pools, palm trees and sunshine, think casual. But remember, hotel meeting space with "zone" AC, can fluctuate from sweltering to freezing! Pack long sleeves & dress in easy-to-adjust layers. Days are long and the hotel is huge pack comfy clothes & comfy shoes. Business casual works for the conference & banquets jacket & tie totally optional. Pack for the pool, health club, tennis, golf. Pack your favorite noshes nuts, dried fruit, prunes, power bars, chocolate, tea bags. Pack notepaper it's not provided. And bring an extra suitcase to carry home all the books, DVDs, & funky marriage t-shirts you'll buy.

- Attractions: Disney, Universal, Sea World, etc are 10 mins down the road. An hour west: the Gulf of Mexico with Caladesi, ranked the #1 most beautiful beach in the country. An hour east, on the Atlantic: Kennedy Space Center & 30 mins north: St Augustine, the oldest city and fort in the U.S. Or add on a few days & head south to Miami, South Beach, the Everglades and the Keys. - <u>Avis Discounts:</u> Why Avis when Enterprise has a desk at the hotel? Avis: lower rates; open Sun; a lot near the hotel with FREE pick up/drop off you can pick up at the hotel & return at the airport, with no extra fee. (Enterprise charges a \$50 airport drop-off fee). Use Smart Marriages code #D086788 (5-20% off good June 29 July 20). Pick up at the airport or call 407-370-3231 an hour in advance to schedule pick-up from the lot near the hotel Lot #E2F.

<u>In case you're wondering,</u> the 2nd most frequent complaint is that we don't have a cloning machine and there are too many great sessions all scheduled at the same time. As soon as a cloner is available, we'll rent one. In the meantime, we've got you covered - we record ALL workshops & keynotes. Relax and listen without taking notes.
