The #1 skill in all relationships is communication – this is particularly true in the intense, committed relationship we call marriage. Carri developed "The Lenses" to show you the filters and layers that can cause communication collisions. You will hear the communication accidents and repairs from other couples as well as how to "cross the street" into another person's world.

APPLES & ORANGES

(16 minutes running time)

First marriages are apples – subsequent marriages are oranges. In this presentation basic fundamental differences between the two that many people don't even think about will be explored. The stepfamily forms backwards from the biological family. Without recognizing and preparing for these differences, the stepfamily – and those working with them – are set up for major problems.

(21 minutes running time)

The most unpredictable element in stepfamily formation is relationship development. This presentation explores and literally draws out, how individuals bond and relationships develop in the stepfamily. This is also contrasted with the biological family.

WHAT ABOUT US?

In Apples and Oranges the differences between first families and subsequent families and how stepfamilies form backwards were presented.
